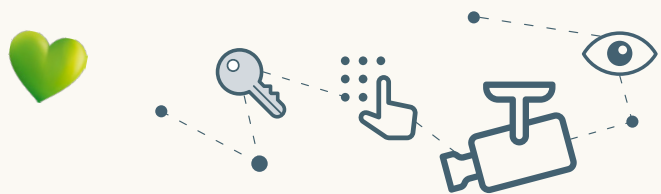
## Reducing the risk of theft

### Here's what you can do to reduce the risk of car theft



- **Protect your key fob:** To prevent keyless car theft, keep the key away from where the vehicle is kept when not in use. A key fob protector should also be used.
- **Lock up and switch off:** Avoid leaving your car vacant and running idle and unattended. Even if you're keeping the car running briefly to maintain battery life, ensure that you stay with your vehicle.
- **Don't give thieves an easy ride:** Use security gates when parking on the drive.
- **Avoid advertising your stuff:** Remove all personal belongings from your vehicle.
- **Store paperwork at home:** Don't put personal documents or even spare keys in your car.
- **Get visual:** It's worth considering installing security cameras and lighting for your car.
- **Use a steering wheel lock:** This adds both protection to your car and deters would-be thieves.
